By clicking the "Edit" link next to their name, the system will now provide a list of all parties on the case who are not represented by the attorney. To associate a party, the attorney should click the green '+' plus button next to the party name. Multiple parties may be associated at one time by clicking each '+'. Once the party(s) have been selected, the attorney must click the 'Update' button. The screen will refresh and the association will be displayed. The case itself will not be updated however, until the attorney clicks the 'Submit' button at the bottom of the eFiling – Existing Case screen. Attorneys will not be able to remove associations in JEFS. That will require contacting the court.
