IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all deadlines, time schedules, and filing requirements imposed by statutes, rules, or court orders, in all civil, criminal, and administrative matters in the circuit, district and family courts in the State of Hawai'i that expire between March 23, 2020 through and including April 3, 2020, are extended to April 6, 2020.

This order may be modified or extended as necessary.
