All circuit court civil trials, both jury and non-jury, shall be rescheduled to dates after April 30, 2020.

Except for civil proceedings deemed urgent by the presiding judge, all circuit court civil hearings or in-person conferences shall be continued and rescheduled for a

later date, unless the assigned judge finds that the proceedings can be held through telephonic or video conferencing and can be electronically recorded, or the judge determines the hearing can be converted to a non-hearing matter suitable for disposition under Rule 8 of the Rules of the Circuit Court, State of Hawai'i. The parties shall contact the assigned court to schedule or re-schedule hearings.
