

Protective Orders

Mehn Kalohk en Sawas en Silasil

Any person, regardless of his or her immigration or citizenship status, has a right to live in a safe environment, free from the threat of harm from a family member or an acquaintance. If someone you know is engaging in a pattern of harassment or abuse (including physical abuse or sexual abuse, verbal threats, property damage or stalking), you can seek protection by filing a petition and obtaining a temporary restraining order (TRO) against the perpetrator.

Aramas sohte lipilipil, mehnda ma re pidelong nan sahpw pahn kosonned de soh de re tohn wehi de soh, mie ahr pwuhng en kouson wasa me sohte keper, wasa me sohte mie emen tohn peneinei de ienge me pahn kamedekehla. Ma mie emen me ke ese me kin kalapw lider de wiakawe (iangahki wiakauwe paliwar de ahng kehla, lokaiahn kamedekehla, kawehlah dipwisou de pwakih seli emen ni sohte mweimwei), ke pahn kak repen sawas en silasil oh kapidolong doaropwehn pekipek en sawas ong mehn kalohk en ansou mwotomwot (TRO) pwehn irehdihsang me wia tiahk suwedo en karanihiuk.

- In the **District Court**, if you need to extend the TRO for your protection, you may request an injunction for up to three years.
Nan **Mwoalen Kopwung en Wehi**, ma ke anahne kareireila TRO pwehn sinsileiuk, ke kak pekihda mehn kalohk en lel sounpar siluh.
- In the **Family Court**, if the TRO is against a family or household member and you need to extend the TRO-for your protection, you may request an order for protection for any reasonable period of time.
Nan **Mwoalen Kopwung en Peneinei**, ma noumw TRO ong emen tohn peneinei de tohn ihmw oh ma ke anahne kareireila TRO-pwehn sinsileiuk, ke kak pekihda mehn kalohk pwehn silehdi ong irair en ansou me konehng.

If granted, the order sets guidelines aimed at protecting you. This can include prohibiting the defendant/respondent from calling or visiting you.

- If the defendant is not related to you by blood and you have never lived together, please file through [District Court](#).
Ma mehn pahn kadipo sohte penienei kin uhk ni palien inta oh sohte pak kumwa kouson pene, menlau kapidolong doaropwe ni **Mwoalen Kopwung en Wehi**.
- If the defendant/respondent (person to be restrained) is a family or household member, or someone with whom you are or were in a dating relationship with, please file through [Family Court](#).
