Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:</p> <p>It is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means because the Children's Justice Centers selected the aforementioned providers based upon their demonstrated specialized knowledge, skills and experience to conduct forensic interviews of children who are alleged victims of abuse or who are witnesses to violence. Providers are familiar with the Judiciary system and understand how to handle cases in which are presented for their skillset.</p>

Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:</p> <p>Due to the specific experience required as well as the absence of other suitable providers, the above mentioned providers were selected to conduct forensic interviews of children who are allegedly abused or who have been witnesses to violence. Providers' skillset are what the Judiciary requires to assess the cases that are in need of services.</p>
