<p>6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: It is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means because Alaka'i Mechanical is a local available vendor who knows the specifics as required by state standards and codes as recommended by state boiler inspector. Alaka'i Mechanical is the only contractor in the state that specialize with connection of hot water storage as described type in accordance to building code.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Alaka'i Mechanical was chosen since vendor is a local contractor able to meet the state standards and codes. There are specialized contractors for installation and connection work to hot water storage tanks but will be from outside of state of Hawaii. There will be additional airfare, transportation, meals and lodging cost should an out of state vendor were to do the work. With the additional costs as described it would not be practical or to our advantage to procure through a contractor per out of state.</p>
