<u>CIRCUIT COURT OF THE FIFTH CIRCUIT'S ORDER</u> <u>REGARDING THE REOPENING OF DISTRICT COURT ON JUNE 1, 2020.</u>

This matter comes before the Court in light of the public health emergency in the State of Hawai'i.

Pursuant to the Order of Chief Justice Mark E. Recktenwald filed March 16, 2020 under SCMF No. 20-0000152 regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) and with authority as Chief Judge of the above-entitled Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The District Court of the Fifth Circuit will resume full operation of all civil and criminal calendars on June 1, 2020.

2. Pursuant to Governor Ige's Eighth Supplemental Proclamation Related to the COVID-19 Emergency, issued on May 18, 2020, there remains a moratorium on residential evictions based

on a tenant's failure to pay rent, maintenance fees, utility charges, taxes or other fees required for the residential dwelling unit.

3. Any person entering Judiciary facilities shall wear a face covering as described and recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Social distancing measures will be implemented within the courthouse.

4. No person shall enter Judiciary facilities if they have: (1) a fever, cough, or other respiratory symptoms; or (2) traveled off-island in the past 14 days; or (3) had prolonged contact with a person who has or is suspected to have COVID-19. If you fall within these categories please contact the Court Clerk at (808) 482-2645 to reschedule your court appearance.

5. This order may be modified or extended as necessary.
