Pursuant to the Orders of Chief Justice Mark E. Recktenwald filed April 27, 2020 and May 22, 2020 under SCMF No. 20-0000152 regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) and with authority as Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the Fifth Circuit, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The Family Court of the Fifth Circuit will resume full operation of all civil, juvenile, and criminal calendars on June 1, 2020.
- 2. Any person entering the Judiciary facilities shall wear a face covering as described and recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Social distancing measures will be implemented within the courthouse.

- 3. No person shall enter Judiciary facilities if they have: (1) a fever, cough, or other respiratory symptoms; or (2) traveled off-island in the past 14 days; or (3) had prolonged contact with a person who has or is suspected to have COVID-19. If you fall within these categories, please contact the Court Clerk at (808) 482-2391 to reschedule your court appearance.
- All pretrial conferences will be conducted by telephone or videoconferencing.
 Please contact Family Court staff at (808) 482-2391 to arrange a conference call or videoconference.
- 5. This order may be modified as necessary.
