This matter comes before the Court in light of the public health emergency in the

State of Hawai`i.

Pursuant to the Order of Chief Justice Mark E. Recktenwald, filed May 22, 2020,

under SCMF No. 20-0000152 regarding the COVID-19 virus and with authority as Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the Fifth Circuit, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. All criminal jury trials will be continued until after June 30, 2020. This order does not affect any order regarding non-jury trials.

- 2. The Grand Jury sessions for June 2020 and thereafter will proceed as scheduled.
- Proceedings in criminal matters should be heard by video conference or telephone conference to the extent possible. If all parties do not have access to the necessary technology for a video conference, telephonic appearances may be done.
- 4. All persons entering the court building and all court employees who have contact with customers shall wear a face covering as described and recommended by the CDC.
- 5. All previous orders remain in effect, subject to my further modifications.
