ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE ITEMS DUE TO BE FILED  
OR TO CONDUCT HEARINGS REQUIRED TO BE HELD ON  
JULY 27, 2020 IN ALL COURTS IN THE FIRST AND FIFTH CIRCUITS

In consideration of the closing of all Courts in the First Circuit (Island of Oahu), including the Supreme Court and the Intermediate Court of Appeals, and all courts in the Fifth Circuit (Island of Kaua'i) due to severe weather conditions brought on by Hurricane Douglas, and, under the authority of Hawai'i Revised Statutes § 601-2 and article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due on Monday, July 27, 2020 in all courts in the First and Fifth Circuits, is extended to Tuesday, July 28, 2020. All documents due to have been filed shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by Tuesday, July 28, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of all the courts in the First and Fifth Circuits shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
