ORDER AMENDING RULE 24 AND FORM 4

OF THE HAWAI'I RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

(By: Recktenwald, C.J., Nakayama, McKenna, and Wilson, JJ.)¹

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 24 of the Hawai'i Rules of Appellate Procedure is amended, effective immediately upon the entry of this order, as follows (deleted material is bracketed and stricken, new material is underscored):

Rule 24. PROCEEDINGS IN FORMA PAUPERIS.

(a) Leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis from a [the circuit, district, family, land, environmental, or tax appeal] court or [from an] agency determination to the Hawai'i appellate courts. A motion for leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis from [the circuit, district, family, land, environmental, or tax appeal] a court[,] or [from an-]agency determination[,] shall ordinarily be made in the first instance to the court or agency appealed from.

A party to an action in [the circuit, district, family, land, environmental, or tax appeal] a court[,] or [before an] administrative agency who desires to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis may file in the appellate court a motion for leave to so proceed. The motion shall be accompanied by a [n affidavit or] declaration, showing, in the detail prescribed by Form 4 in [of] the Appendix of Forms of these Rules, the party's inability to pay the required filing fees or to give security for costs and[7] the party's belief that the party[he or she] is entitled to redress, and a statement of the issues that the party intends to present on appeal]. [If the appeal is from a court, T[t]he motion shall show that application to the court or agency appealed from for the relief sought is not practicable, or that the court or agency appealed from has denied an application, or has failed to afford the requested relief, with the reasons given by the court <u>or agency</u> appealed from for its action. A party who has filed such a motion may file [his or her]the notice of appeal without being required to prepay the filing fees. If the motion is granted, the party may proceed with the appeal without prepayment of fees or costs or the giving of security therefor.

- (b) Effect of prior leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u>. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, a party who has been permitted to proceed in an action in a court or agency <u>in forma pauperis</u>, or who has been permitted to proceed as one who is financially unable to obtain adequate defense in a criminal case, may proceed on appeal in the same action <u>in forma pauperis</u> without further authorization unless, before or after the notice of appeal is filed, the court or agency [shall certify that the appeal is not taken in good faith or shall] finds that the party is otherwise not entitled so to proceed, in which event the court or agency shall state in writing the reasons for such [certification or] finding.
- (c) Effect of denial of motion for leave to proceed <u>in forma</u> <u>pauperis</u>. If the motion to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> is denied, the movant shall, within 10 days after the denial of such a motion, pay all unpaid filing fees and shall give security for costs. Failure of the unsuccessful movant to pay the unpaid filing fees or to give security for costs shall not affect the validity of the appeal, but is ground for such action as the appellate court having jurisdiction over the appeal deems appropriate, and may include dismissal of the appeal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Form 4, attached hereto, is adopted and shall be appended to the Hawai'i Rules of Appellate

Procedure in place of the previous Form 4, effective immediately upon the entry of this order.
