AT THE HONOLULU DISTRICT COURT (KAUIKEAOULI HALE)

Effective immediately, parties and attorneys are permitted to appear remotely via
Zoom in traffic and criminal cases at the `Ewa District Court, the Kāne`ohe District Court, the
Wahiawā District Court, the Wai`anae District Court, and Courtrooms 4A, 4B, 7A, 7B, 10C, and
10D at the Honolulu District Court (Kauikeaouli Hale) for (1) traffic infraction hearings, (2)
arraignment and plea, (3) status hearings, (4) pretrial conferences, (5) demand/waiver of jury
trial, (6) change of plea, and (7) proof of compliance hearings.

Parties and attorneys appearing for these matters in the courtrooms designated above do not need to file ex parte motions for remote hearings. Instructions on “How to Join a Court Remote Hearing Using Zoom” are available at:

In the event the presiding judge in his or her sole discretion determines that a case is not suitable for a remote hearing, the presiding judge may require the parties and their counsel to appear in person for subsequent court dates. Remote appearances are not currently permitted for trials and evidentiary hearings.
