3. Describe the goods and/or services:

This exemption is for Capgemini America Inc. to provide technical consulting services for the Judiciary's existing case management system (JIMS) to migrate the Family Court Civil case type from the mainframe system HAJIS to JIMS and provide maintenance and enhancements for the existing JIMS system.

4. Explain in detail what is being amended:

Amending services to modify system to implement eTraffic/IVR development. Decriminalization of the emergency order violations requires the system to modify the charge codes, setup the new fees associated to these charges and make credit card payment possible through our website, eTraffic, or using a telephone via IVR for these charges as the system currently has certain conditions that prevent certain citations to be paid on-line or over the phone.

\$39,125

6. Explain in detail why the amendment(s) are necessary:

The eTraffic/IVR development is necessary due to the the large number of citations that have been issued for violations of the emergency orders. The increase of citations have put a burden on the Judiciary staff as these citations need to be processed manually which creates large backlogs. Modifying the system will enable these citations to be processed as infractions and enable the public to pay these citations on-line or over the phone via IVR in a more efficient and timely manner.
