EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 15 REGARDING CIRCUIT COURT OF THE SECOND CIRCUIT, STATE OF HAWAI'I

Pursuant to the Order of Chief Justice Mark E. Recktenwald filed DECEMBER 20, 2020, under SCMF No. 20-0000152 regarding entering Judiciary Facilities and with the authority as Chief Judge of the above-entitled Court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all fully-vaccinated deputy sheriffs assigned to the Second Circuit may enter the Second Circuit Judiciary facilities after traveling within the State of Hawai`i only if

- a) the travel was work-related pursuant to a Court order;
- b) the deputy sheriffs are asymptomatic for COVID-19;
- c) the deputy sheriffs receive a COVID-19 test upon return; and
- d) the deputy sheriffs receive a negative result prior to entry into the

Second Circuit Judiciary facilities.
