ORDER

(By: Recktenwald, C.J.)

On January 7, 2021, the Supreme Court adopted Rule 23 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai‘i (RSCH) creating the Commission to Promote and Advance Civic Education (“PACE Commission”). Pursuant to RSCH Rule 23(c), and the designations made by the various appointing authorities set forth in RSCH Rule 23(c)(2), the following individuals shall make up the membership of the PACE Commission:
