On January 7, 2021, the Supreme Court adopted Rule 23 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai‘i (RSCH) creating the Commission to Promote and Advance Civic Education (“PACE Commission”). Pursuant to RSCH Rule 23(c), and the designation made by the Honorable Ronald D. Kouchi, President of the Hawai‘i Senate, **Senator Dru M. Kanuha** is appointed as a member of the PACE Commission.

Senator Kanuha’s term shall be for a period of three years, effective immediately upon the filing of this Order, and expiring on April 4, 2024.
