Rule 2. DISCIPLINARY RULES.

2.22. Confidentiality.

(c) Disclosure of evidence of infirmity. ~~[The Chairperson of the Board, upon receipt of trustworthy evidence, may authorize]~~ Disciplinary Counsel, in its discretion, may [to] disclose an attorney's possible substance abuse, physical or

mental illness, or other infirmity to the Director of the Attorney and Judges Assistance Program.
