**THIRTEENTH AMENDED EMERGENCY ORDER #2 REGARDING  
CIRCUIT COURT OF THE FIRST CIRCUIT, CRIMINAL MATTERS**

This matter comes before the Court in light of the public health emergency in the State of Hawai'i.

In light of the recent surge in COVID-19 infection and hospitalization rates throughout the State of Hawai'i with record numbers of positive cases being reported, the First Circuit Courts will continue to conduct remote proceedings while also implementing additional precautions to reduce the number of people congregating in Judiciary facilities.

To further protect the health and safety of First Circuit Court employees and all court participants, and pursuant to the Orders of Chief Justice Mark E. Recktenwald filed as of August 16, 2021 under SCMF No. 20-0000152, In re the Judiciary's Response to the COVID-19 Outbreak, and with authority as Chief Judge of the above-entitled Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. All grand jury proceedings shall be postponed to dates after October 4, 2021.
2. All other emergency orders issued in the Circuit Court of the First Circuit shall remain in effect, subject to further modification.
3. This Order may be modified as circumstances warrant, but absent further action, this Order shall remain in effect.

It is so Ordered.
