ORDER MODIFYING FIRST EXTENSION OF ORDER POSTPONING JURY TRIALS

On September 29, 2021, I issued an order further postponing jury trials to dates after November 16, 2021. In order to provide a full week of jury trials upon resumption, it is necessary for jury trials to resume on Monday, the week of November 15, 2021.

Therefore, pursuant to article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Hawai‘i Constitution and Hawai‘i Revised Statutes §§ 601-1.5 and 601-2,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the September 29, 2021 First Extension of Order Postponing Jury Trials is modified to provide that jury trials may resume on Monday, November 15, 2021. The September 29, 2021 Order remains in effect in all other respects.
