**TWELFTH AMENDED EMERGENCY ORDER #3 REGARDING
CIRCUIT COURT OF THE FIRST CIRCUIT, CIVIL MATTERS**

This matter comes before the Court in light of the public health emergency in the State of Hawai'i.

To further protect the health and safety of First Circuit Court employees and all court participants, and pursuant to the Orders of Chief Justice Mark E. Recktenwald filed as of October 15, 2021 under SCMF No. 20-0000152 regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) and with authority as Chief Judge of the above-entitled Court, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Jury trials may resume on November 15, 2021.

2. All other emergency orders issued in the Circuit Court of the First Circuit shall remain in effect, subject to further modification.

3. Court users are reminded that all hearing motions via Zoom video conferencing shall include a Notice of Remote Hearing in a form that substantially complies with the form attached to this Order.¹

Attorneys and self-represented parties must enter a user name that sets forth their full name, otherwise you will not be admitted into the hearing. Attorneys must also include the suffix "Esq."

All attorneys and parties shall dress appropriately for the hearing. **Recording court proceedings is strictly prohibited unless permission is granted by the court.** The court may impose sanctions for failure to comply with this notice.
