6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: It is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means because the original digital interview recording management systems, including both hardware and software were installed based on a pilot project which ran for one (1) month. Upon the successful pilot project, Program/Division was satisfied and moved forward with all nine (9) CJC locations statewide. Word Systems, Inc. is the only provider able to maintain and repair the current system that are installed at the CJC Hawaii Statewide locations.

An IFB procurement process was initiated and completed in calendar year 2014, resulting awarding a contract to Precise Digital. Subsequent to installation of this system at the CJC's statewide, major problems occurred with no permanent resolution. This included problems recording child abuse victim interviews and making copies of the DVD interviews. The problem had major negative impact on cases, adding more trauma to victims and compromising access to justice for parties.

7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: After a successful pilot program and along with the addition nine (9) systems for the CJC Hawaii Statewide locations, Word Systems, Inc. has proven beyond the Judiciary's expectations to provide outstanding service. Word Systems, Inc. is the only provider able to maintain and repair the current system that are installed at the CJC Hawaii Statewide locations. Word Systems, Inc. would be the only suitable vendor with the proper training and expertise able to service and maintain both the hardware and software of the system and will insure the system works properly. It is vital to maintain the high level of service and quality of both the hardware and software, as such Word Systems, Inc. will be able to provide such quality due to knowledge of the system and understanding of how critical the systems are to CJC Hawaii purpose.
