ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE ITEMS DUE TO BE FILED

In consideration of the continued closure of Ali‘iōlani Hale and Kapuaiwa Building on Wednesday, December 8, 2021, due to power outages from the storm, and under the authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 601-2 and article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,
