The Court finds that Governor David Ige shall allow his emergency orders pertaining to COVID-19 to lapse on their own accord on March 26, 2022. In addition, The Honorable Mark E. Recktenwald, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Hawai'i, by order dated March 21, 2022 has rescinded his orders regarding entering Judiciary facilities and attorney vaccination and testing requirements pertaining to COVID-19 effective March 26, 2022. In light of these actions by Governor Ige and Chief Justice Recktenwald, this Court enters the following order: IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that prior orders of this Court pertaining to COVID-19 issued by any Chief Judge after March 13, 2020 are rescinded effective 12:01 A.M., March 26, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that operational matters concerning Second Circuit Court, including the rural courts in Lahaina, Hana, Molokai and Lana'i shall be addressed by administrative memo.
