EMERGENCY ORDERS OF THE FIFTH CIRCUIT

The Court finds that Governor David Y. Ige shall allow his emergency orders pertaining to COVID-19 to lapse of their own accord on March 26, 2022. Further, in light of Chief Justice Mark E. Recktenwald rescinding his orders regarding entering Judiciary facilities and attorney vaccination and testing requirements pertaining to COVID-19 and with authority as Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the Fifth Circuit, effective March 26, 2022, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. All prior emergency COVID-19 orders of the Fifth Circuit are rescinded.
- 2. Entry: Active screening for entry into the Fifth Circuit Courthouse will cease.

- Facemask: Facemask or face coverings will not be mandatory in the Fifth Circuit Courthouse.
- 4. Social Distancing: Social distancing will not be mandatory in the Fifth Circuit Courthouse.
- Zoom or Remote Hearings: This order should not be construed to limit the use of Zoom or remote hearings, which is left to the discretion of the presiding Judge of each Court.
