ORDER RESCINDING ALL PREVIOUS COVID-19
EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS

The Court finds that Governor David Y. Ige shall allow his emergency orders pertaining to COVID-19 to lapse by their own accord on March 26, 2022. Further, in light of Chief Justice Mark E. Recktenwald rescinding his orders regarding entering Judiciary facilities and attorney vaccination and testing requirements pertaining to COVID-19, and with the authority as Chief Judge of the Third Circuit Court:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all prior emergency COVID-19 administrative orders of the Third Circuit are rescinded effective 12:01 a.m., March 26, 2022. This order does not rescind the Order Regarding Act 57 Cases Filed With The District Court Of The Third Circuit filed July 28, 2021, which is hereby ordered to expire on August 6, 2022.

This order should not be construed to limit the use of Zoom remote hearings, which is left to the discretion of each court.
