This consultant shall provide ongoing training and consultation to CJC staff and professionals of cooperating agencies in the area of child maltreatment. It will also include travel between islands when CJC Forensic Interview Specialists are not available.</p>

Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: It is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means because the Children's Justice Centers selected the aforementioned Provider based upon her demonstrated specialized knowledge, skills and experience to conduct forensic interviews of children who are alleged victims of abuse or who are witnesses to violence. It was not practicable or advantageous to procure by competitive means because there is an absence of other suitable Providers who have the specific experience required to conduct these services. Also, the Provider is familiar with the Judiciary system and understand how to handle cases in which are presented for their skill set.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Due to the specific experience required as well as the absence of other suitable providers, the above-mentioned provider was selected to conduct forensic interviews of children who are allegedly abused or who have been witnesses to violence. Provider's skill set is what the Judiciary requires to assess the cases that are in need of services.</p>
