Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: Security Resources Pacific, Inc. is the current maintenance Contractor for the Kauai Judiciary Complex access control system which includes the surveillance system. Security Resources Pacific, Inc. is the only certified &amp; authorized vendor to work with our access control system, Premisys, in Hawaii. They are trained to install, service &amp; maintain. Security Resources has continuously &amp; consistently provided timely support n repairs &amp; troubleshooting any issues that occur. They will be integrating with our access control system to allow for the remote release of the door &amp; use of security camera video feeds from within the secured hallways. Therefore, it is not practicable or not advantageous to procure by competitive means to avoid the uncertainties and complications of involving multiple vendors for the security system.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Security Resources Pacific, Inc. is the current maintenance Contractor for the Kauai Judiciary Complex access control system which includes the surveillance system. The contract was procured as an exemption. Also, due to Security Resources Pacific, Inc. being the only authorized Premisys vendor in Hawaii, Security Resources Pacific, Inc. was selected to install &amp; continue providing maintenance services.</p>
