SRP is the Judiciary's current vendor and is performing satisfactorily as the maintenance and support contractor for Hilo courthouse security systems. SRP's maintenance contract, J22217, was procured as a small purchase. SRP was selected because they are Hawaii's only authorized representative for PDC Identicard, the manufacture of Hilo's security system. Selecting another vendor may create uncertainties and complications within the system.
