videos, annunciate duress alarms, and provide real-time information of the overall site. These nodes as well as each system are only maintainable and serviceable by SRP. Maintenance or service provided by others may degrade the functionality of each system which may result in loss of video, duress alarm annunciation or control of the access system.

The current video surveillance, access control, and duress systems are integrated via nodes that were provided at the time of installation of each system. Each node communicates to the other nodes which monitor system statuses, display

SRP currently maintains the Judiciary access control database which integrates the duress alarms and video monitoring from other circuits. Service provided by any company other than SRP may void maintenance contracts from other circuits.
