6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:

It is not practicable nor advantageous for the Juvenile Detention Facility to procure food by competitive means because the Program cannot predict nor determine the amount of food that is needed in an emergency. Program is unable to foresee when they do not have any cooks to prepare the food or if there is no driver to deliver food to Home Maluhia. The Juvenile Detention Facility cannot predict nor write specs on the amount and type of food program to purchase for the year. Another reason is program cannot predict the frequency and/or amount of plate lunches to order to cover the demand.

7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:

The three (3) vendors listed above were based on the history of service and products supplies to the Juvenile Detention Facility with a short lead time. Vendors are able to fulfill orders completely. Vendors accept Judiciary purchase orders which allows for a more efficient and easier process in the time of emergency.
