Equipment to be installed on both 1st & 2nds floors to the main entrances to the secured hallways & for each chamber office door in the Kauai Judicial Complex.</p>

Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means: Security Resources Pacific, Inc. is the only certified & authorized vendor to work with our access control system, Premisys, in Hawaii. They are trained to install, service & maintain. Security Resources Pacific has continuously & consistently provided timely support in repairs & troubleshooting any issues that occur. The intercom upgrade will be integrated with our access control system for the remote unlocking of the main entrances to the secured chambers hallways as well as their chamber office doors.</p>	
<p>7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider: Security Resources Pacific, Inc. was selected as the contractor for maintenance of the access control system, Premisys, at the Kauai Judiciary Complex as they are the only certified & authorized Premisys vendor in Hawaii. The maintenance contract with Security Resources Pacific, Inc. was initially procured through a large purchase. Security Resources Pacific, Inc. shall integrate the intercom equipment with the current access control system, Premisys, & will also be added to our maintenance contract.</p>
