Upon consideration of the February 15, 2023 report from the Access to Justice Commission regarding the Tenant Volunteer Attorney and Volunteer Assistant Pilot Program, we conclude that an extension of the program is warranted. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Tenant Volunteer

Attorney and Volunteer Assistant Pilot Program in the Second

Circuit of the State of Hawai'i is extended to March 31, 2024, at which time this court may make a determination whether the program should be extended further or made permanent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Access to Justice Commission shall submit to this court, no later than February 28, 2024, a report on the status of the Pilot Program, with a recommendation regarding the long-term fate of the program.
