In consideration of the closing of the Kaneohe Courthouse (Abner Paki Hale), District Court of the First Circuit, due to a power outage, and, under the authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 601-2, and article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due at the Kaneohe Courthouse (Abner Paki Hale) on Wednesday, March 8, 2023, is extended to Thursday, March 9, 2023. All documents due to have been filed shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by Thursday, March 9, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of the Kaneohe Courthouse (Abner Paki Hale), shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
