

1. The Defendant was previously found unfit to proceed in this case and remains unfit to proceed at the present time;

- 3. The Defendant has remained released on conditions for a period of <u>120</u> days;
 - 4. The Defendant is <u>not</u> subject to prosecution for other charges; and
- 5. The Defendant is <u>not</u> subject to HRS Section 334-60.2 regarding involuntary hospitalization criteria.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The misdemeanor charge(s) for which the Defendant has been released on conditions in the above-captioned matter are hereby DISMISSED; and
- 2. The Defendant shall be immediately discharged from the release conditions and further supervision of the Court.
