6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:
Leidos Security Detection & Automation, Inc. acquired L-3 Communications Security & Detection Systems, Inc., who was the proprietary provider of this brand of x-ray units. Due to the technical nature of the equipment and our reliance on this equipment to provide our courts with a safe and secure environment, it is essential that we retain Leidos' services to ensure proper equipment performance up to manufacturer specifications. In addition to receiving prioritized response to service calls, preventive maintenance will be performed on the x-ray units.

7. Explain in detail, the process that will be or was utilized in selecting the vendor/contractor/service provider:
Leidos acquired L-3, who was the manufacturer of this equipment and they have the expertise and experience in maintaining the proprietary system. Leido is the only company in Hawaii able to provide certified maintenance services for this equipment located at Hoapili Hale.
