ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION TO DISMISS
APPELLEE HAWAI‘I LAW ENFORCEMENT CREDIT UNION

Upon consideration of the Stipulation to Dismiss Appellee Hawai‘i Law Enforcement Federal Credit Union With Prejudice (Stipulation), filed July 14, 2023, by Defendant-Appellee Hawai‘i Law Enforcement Federal Credit Union, the papers in support, and the record, it appears that: (1) the filing fees have been paid, but the appeal has not been docketed; (2) the parties stipulate to dismiss Hawai‘i Law Enforcement Federal Credit Union with prejudice and agree that each party is responsible for its own fees and costs relative to the Stipulation; (3) the Stipulation is dated and signed by counsel for all parties; and (4) dismissal is authorized by Hawai‘i Rules of Appellate Procedure Rule 42(a).
