Upon consideration of the Stipulation to Dismiss
Appellee Hawai'i Law Enforcement Federal Credit Union With
Prejudice (Stipulation), filed July 14, 2023, by DefendantAppellee Hawai'i Law Enforcement Federal Credit Union, the papers
