regarding remote appearances by defendants at post-arraignment,

Rules 11 and 43 of the Hawai‘i Rules of Penal Procedure which
will take effect on January 1, 2024, we conclude that a further
extension of the Pilot Project, to January 1, 2024, is
warranted. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Pilot Project for Remote Appearances by Defendants at Post-Arraignment, Change-of-Plea Hearings is extended *nunc pro tunc* from July 20, 2023 to January 1, 2024.
