Explain in detail why the amendment(s) are necessary: It is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means because the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges (NCJFCJ) is the only known organization with a mission of training and supporting family court judges in all areas that impact children and families referred to the court. Hawaii has been a model court since 1990's for NCJFCF and Hawaii is currently on "senior" court status with NCJFCJ. The existing contract with NCJFCJ was negotiated to conduct statewide assessments (baseline assessment, recommendation implementation and improvement assessment). NCJFCJ is knowledgeble in the requirements of the CIP issued by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).  NCJFCJ is instrumental in the assessment of court hearings aimed at improving all aspects of the child welfare court hearing as they are aware of the Hawaii Judiciary process (statutes, court rules, and court procedures) through the completion of statewide site visits, assessments and reports. Continuing with NCJFCJ reduces the training of a new contractor with Hawaii Judiciary Family Court practices, the expectations of the CIP, and the practices of the stakeholders. In light of this it would not be feasible to conduct another solicitation.
