ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

Upon review of the record, it appears that:

- (1) The opening brief was due on or before March 4, 2024;
- (2) Respondents-Appellants Pamela Richards Ketchum and John A. Richards (Appellants) failed to file the opening brief or request another extension of time;
- (3) On March 6, 2024, the appellate clerk entered a default notice informing Appellants that the time for filing the opening brief expired March 6, 2023, the matter would be called to the court's attention on March 18, 2024, for appropriate action, which could include dismissal of the appeal, under Hawai'i Rules of Appellate Procedure Rule 30, and Appellants could request relief from default by motion;
- (4) On March 12, 2024, the appellate clerk entered an amended default notice to correct the opening brief filing deadline to March 4, 2024; and
