Upon review of the record, it appears that:

(1) The statement of jurisdiction and opening brief were due on or before January 16, 2024, and February 13, 2024, respectively;

(2) Self-represented Defendant-Appellant Heath Jonathan Vaughan (Appellant) failed to file either document, or request an extension of time;

(3) On March 4, 2024, the appellate clerk entered a default notice informing Appellant that the time for filing the statement of jurisdiction and opening brief had expired, the matter would be called to the court's attention on March 14, 2024, for appropriate action, which could include dismissal of the appeal, under Hawai'i Rules of Appellate Procedure
