Originally installed at Ali'iolani Hale in 1997, the System was designed to detect, alert occupants and emergency first responders of the presence of fire, smoke, carbon monoxide, or other fire-related issues. The System consists of smoke detectors, duct detectors, manual fire alarm activation devices (pull stations), audio sirens, visual strobes and magnetic door holders which have been strategically placed throughout the two story courthouse. If activated, the System will also contact emergency first responders via an automatic digital dialer. All of the above components are connected to the MCP of the System. Although still functioning after 27 years of service, the MCP has reached it's end of life and is now considered obsolete. Most replacement parts are no longer available for this MCP model. If any major issue occurs with the MCP, the System will be completely down. To prevent this situation and maintain continual operation of the System, the MCP must be replaced with a newer version.
