ORDER DISMISSING CASE

(By: Leonard, Acting Chief Judge, Hiraoka and Guidry, JJ.)

Upon review of the record, the court finds that self-represented Defendant-Appellant Eric Stroeve's December 27, 2024 "Petition for Writ of Dismissal" does not notice an appeal from a judgment entered by the Circuit Court of the First Circuit in 1CPC-21-0000568. Hawaii Revised Statutes (**HRS**) § 641-11 (2016). Rather, it appears to seek affirmative relief in the nature of a writ of mandamus and/or writ of habeas corpus, which the Hawai'i Supreme Court has exclusive, original jurisdiction to grant. HRS § 602-5(a)(3), (4) (2016).

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that case No. CAOT-24-0000845 is dismissed without prejudice to seeking relief via petition to the Hawai'i Supreme Court.
