Nineteen additional security cameras is essential for the safety and security of Kapolei Courthouse and its staff. Installing cameras in areas with no cameras in and around the building is vital as it will keep staff judges and staff safe, as it allows sheriffs to monitor these areas that currently have no monitoring. Installing cameras ensures the safety of judges and staff, as sheriffs are allowed to monitor these areas for unauthorized individuals, in addition to responding to an emergency situation like an active shooter. Also, these additional cameras will help in video reviews for incident reports.

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:
