

The caseload activity of the Courts of Appeal, comprised of the Supreme Court and the Intermediate Court of Appeals, reflects the combined workload of the two courts.

Primary Cases are original cases filed in the Office of the Chief Clerk of the Supreme Court. Appeals and original proceedings are classified as primary cases.

Supplemental Proceedings arise out of primary cases. During the fiscal year, of the 2,025 supplemental proceedings filed, 171 were filed in the Supreme Court and 1,854 were filed in the Intermediate Court of Appeals.

^{**} These appeals were filed pursuant to Act 48, which was signed into law on May 10, 2015, and took effect on August 1, 2016 (and was later made permanent pursuant to Act 213 (2019)). Under Act 48, contested case hearings before the Commissions on Water Resource Management (HRS Section 174C), Land Use (HRS Section 205), Public Utilities (HRS Section 269), The Hawai'i Community Development Program (HRS Section 206E), and cases involving Conservation Districts (HRS Section 183C) are to be appealed directly to the Supreme Court.
