5. Explain in detail why this/these amendment(s) is/are necessary.  In the process of procuring and designing the new and separate access control network (ACN) it was discovered that three existing network conduits (two conduits in Ali'iolani Hale and one conduit in the Kapuaiwa Building) for the existing fiber horizontal infrastructure had reached the capacity limit for cabling. Therefore, three new network conduits would need to be installed to allow for the ACN. An electric engineer consultant was procured to design the installation of the three new conduits. The specifications and drawings for the design phase were timely and close to completion. However, delays were encountered during the bidding documents process which in turn affected the Construction / Installation Phase (CIP) of the new conduits. Because the bidding documents were not complete, an attempt to secure Judiciary end of year funds for the CIP was not timely. Without the new conduits in place, the installation of the ACN is held up. Hence the request to extend the current contract for another year to search and procure funds for the CIP.
