Pursuant to HRS § 103D -306 and HAR Chapter 3-122, Subchapter 9, The Judiciary requests an amendment to sole source approval as follows

3. Describe the goods and/or services:

To furnish and install the back end (copper infrastructure) of a new access control network at Ali'iolani Hale and the Kapuaiwa Building. Network cabling contractor Communication Consulting Service, Inc. (CCSI) will install the front end (fiber horizontal infrastructure) of the new access control network. Security contractor Security Resources Pacific (SRP) will complete the back end as SRP is the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Access Control Management System (System) at both buildings.

4. Request to amend is submitted in order to:

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Revise the scope of services for the contract as follows:

No cost one (1) year extension from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026

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Amending Contract price

Original Contract Price: \$244,673.77

Amended Contract Price: N/A

5. Explain in detail why this/these amendment(s) is/are necessary.

In the process of procuring and designing the new and separate access control network (ACN) it was discovered that three existing network conduits (two conduits in Ali'iolani Hale and one conduit in the Kapuaiwa Building) for the existing fiber horizontal infrastructure had reached the capacity limit for cabling. Therefore, three new network conduits would need to be installed to allow for the ACN. An electric engineer consultant was procured to design the installation of the three new conduits. The specifications and drawings for the design phase were timely and close to completion. However, delays were encountered during the bidding documents process which in turn affected the Construction / Installation Phase (CIP) of the new conduits. Because the bidding documents were not complete, an attempt to secure Judiciary end of year funds for the CIP was not timely. Without the new conduits in place, the installation of the ACN is held up. Hence the request to extend the current contract for another year to search and procure funds for the CIP.
