Currently the Third Judicial Circuit does not have any court reporter on staff, reliable and consistent audio visual recording systems are essential for records of court proceedings and for producing timely transcripts. Toward that end, we require a single point of responsibility for our systems' support. It would be counterproductive to introduce mulit-vendor complications into systems that rely on JAVS's proprietary hardware and software.

Proprietary hardware and software comprise key elements of JAVS systems.
