6. Describe in detail the following:

a. The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction.

Kapolei Complex, Juvenile Detention Facility and Hale Hilina'i utilizes the Premisys Access Control Management (ACM) System and has a current maintenance agreement with Security Resources Pacific, Inc. to maintain the proper functionality of the Premisys ACM System. Their system also integrates all of the security and camera systems within the Circuit. The First Circuit has an integrated security management and monitoring system in all of its courthouses. The system includes: the PremiSys Security Management system. PremiSys Access Control Management system, and the American Dynamics Video Edge Victor management system. This system seamlessly integrates security devices into a dynamic Graphical User Interface operating platform. This level of integration requires that the equipment installer is fully capable to install equipment that will integrate into our existing security system. The Judiciary for all these reasons needs an installer that is supported by PremiSys in the event there is a system problem that requires technical assistance or engineering and possesses the expertise required to install and maintain our existing systems.

b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department.

Maintenance of various security systems is essential to court security at Kapolei Court Complex and Juvenile Detention Facility & Hale Hilina'i.

Due to the technical nature of this equipment and our reliance on this equipment to provide our courts with a safe and secure environment, it is essential that we retain Security Resources Pacific, Inc. services to ensure proper equipment performance up to manufacturer specifications.

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:

We made a request to Security Resources Pacific, Inc. whom has the proprietary rights to PremiSys systems as described above to ask what companies were authorized and trained to service, maintain and install the system in Hawaii. As noted in the sole source letter dated 1/29/2025, Security Resources Pacific, Inc. is the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management system, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and the related interface software and hardware. The sole source letter notes that PremiSys will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service our system.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

No alternate source was investigated; as stated in the sole source letter dated 1/29/2025, Security Resources is the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management system, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and the related interface software and hardware. The sole source letter notes the PremiSys will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service our system.
