6. Explain in detail why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the Program/Division to procure by competitive means:								
Judiciary solely relies on ETS for Internet and State network connection; as such, all main Judiciary sites have NGN connection provided by ETS. Currently, Wahiawa courthouse has only 10M HawaiianTel MPLS data connection which frequently experiences slow network issues. The new Wahiawa courthouse will have 1GB data connection from ETS with this NGN installation. As noted in the attached DAGS approved exemption, DCCA, CATV which is the franchising authority, granted Time Warner/Oceanic Cable a cable franchise, entitled "Decision and Order" authorizing the grantee the right to construct and operate a cable system. The federal law grants the CATV Division the right to require as part of the franchise that the cable operator provide capacity for the purpose of the Institutional Network (INET). The State receives connectivity to various government sites through the Time Warner/Oceanic Cable network for INET. This is provided under Decision and Order No. 154, as amended by 156, 158 and 241. No other vendor can provide connectivity to the INET while the franchise agreements are in effect.
